

Dance Game Ideas

Dance Simon Says (recommended for ages 4-9)



Ballet:

-Passé; Battement; Arabesque; Tendu; Degage; first position; second position; third position; fourth position; fifth position; sixth position; relevé; pas de chat; jeté; pas de bourre; chassé

Tap:

-shuffle; flap; paradiddle; shuffle ball change; cramp roll; shuffle hop step; ball heel

Jazz:

-jazz walk; pivot turn; battement; leap; jazz square; body roll; kick ball change; grapevine; lindee; jazz turn; chaine turn

Have Your Dancer be the Teacher!

Have them teach you a skill they are working on or part of their recital dance!

Freeze Dance

Put on your dancer's favorite song and have them dance around. Pause the music and they have to freeze – bonus points if you dress up like Elsa and tell them you've frozen them ☺

Create-a-Dance (Solo showcase when we return)

We have a document where dancers ages 2-6 can roll a dice to help them put movements together to create a dance. Dancers ages 6+ can make up their own dance! Inspiration can come from a movie, a book, a story or their favorite song. These older dancers will be able to share what they come up with once we are back at the studio!
